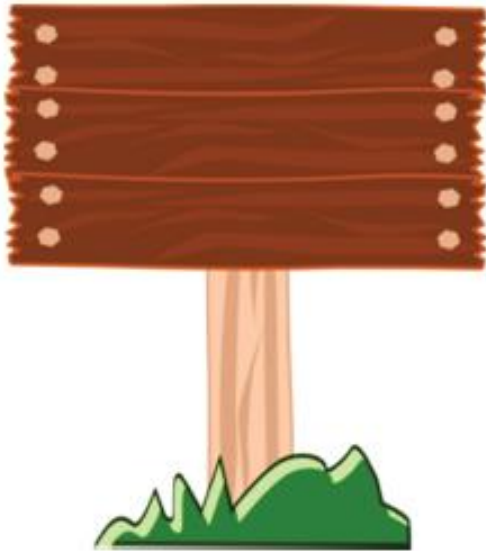

James Thunder provides the Septic Services for Buffalo Point. Getting your tank pumped is just a call away! (Please see number in Contact Info Section). James is committed to providing the best service possible and responds to your call as soon as he can. Please note that there may be times that same-day or next-day service isn't always available – the truck may be in for repairs, weather related issues, high volume of work requests, etc. We ask that you keep this in mind when requesting a pump-out. Check your tank level regularly and don't wait to call when it's at or near capacity – give yourself a few days grace to be safe. For those of you who enjoy the occasional weekend or summer holidays in Buffalo Point, a good rule of thumb is to check your tank when you're leaving rather than when you are arriving. *Please make sure to clear any tree limbs and/or brush to allow the septic truck to access your tank.*

## NEW DROP BOX & PAYMENT OPTIONS

Please be advised that a drop box is being installed just outside the office in order to provide people with another option for making payments. The drop box will allow people to make payments at their convenience, anytime or any day of the week! The drop box is secure (fish-proof) and cemented in the ground; however, we advise that only cheque or money order payments be deposited and NO CASH.

People may continue to make payments at the office during office hours or by mail (P.O. Box 1037, Buffalo Point, MB R0A 2W0). Once the drop box is installed, we kindly ask that people no longer leave payments at the Marina or Resort Centre.
